This is a photo of the hospital in Bungoma Kenya where Patrick Okumu with whom I had the privilege to work for many years lives. I stayed in his house at Kanduyi. One evening I had just arrived from England. A flight from Heathrow and then waited in Nairobi and then a flight to Kisumu and a 2-and-a-half-hour drive to Bungoma, so

almost 9 pm. Given food and then we must go and visit Doctor Chuma (Chuman is Swahili for iron). Dr Chuma worked in the hospital.

Dr Chuma had daughter with sever sickle cell disease and was in her mother's arms. We had to wait while they finished watching football on the TV and then came the opportunity to pray for the daughter. She immediately jumped out of her mothers' arms and was completely healed and a normal child from that moment on

Dr Chuma later had a breakdown and we visited him at his home and prayed and again he was healed and able to return to work and also was able to pray for some sick folk.

On another visit I was taken to a different hospital where the son of a pastor was ill. We eventually we allowed in to pray for the child who was healed and out of hospital the next day. The matron of the hospital was so impressed she made us go to every ward in the hospital and pray for all her patients.
