

Nakuru In Kenya

These are the flamingos on Lake Nakuru. There were lots of visits to Nakuru over the years as it became a place to stay on the way back from Bungoma to Nairobi. We held crusades in the market and saw many healed. 47 were prayed for on one day and all 47 healed. Many were given the microphone to testify on the platform of their healing as we continued to pray for others.

Among the 47 was a lady with Asthma whose breathing changed the moment she was prayed for. She then stood on the platform and testified that she was on the way to the witchdoctor for healing and had heard us preaching and stopped to listen. She had been healed and given her life to the Lord Jesus and realised she would not need the witchdoctor again.

In the same place, on another occasion, a relative of the pastor came for prayer. We did not know him, but he had a reputation of being violent especially towards his family. He smoked and was an alcoholic. After prayer he removed all the cigarettes from his pockets and another pastor lit a fire and burned them in his presence. He has been delivered and for a number of years of follow up was still trusting God in his life having given himself to the Lord Jesus.

We visited churches a couple of times at the back of Lake Nakuru. In one meeting a lady stood up and gave testimony that last time you were here I was dying but God has healed me, and I am well now.

We have seen miracles in our travelling and especially here. It had been raining heavily and there was lots of mud and yet somehow we managed to keep going. We had taken a wrong turn and on arrival asked which way we had come. The comments. "No one has managed to get down that road for 6 months". By the grace of God, we did and were there to be involved in baptising 57 people in the river that day.

There were many more miracles in Nakuru, God always at work in His love for His people.
